It hardly seems possible that we have been out of our church building for one year, unable to meet and greet and hug each other, all due to the pandemic that we could not have foreseen taking place. However, with God's grace and the help of technology and our Pastor who supports all of us through Zoom, we have been able to hold our monthly meetings. We welcomed new members Anita George, Marilyn Gibbs, Theo Osifeso and Cynthia Blades-Woods as our new treasurer

We have renewed our church insurance coverage for the year as of Wednesday March 10th, with a slight increase for Professional Liability and Ultimate Cover Coverage (church buildings and contents). The increase is approximately an additional \$30/month.

As of February 28th we have ended our relationship with McPherson's Property Management and have our own Rev. Kenneth Curl in place taking care of both of our rental properties. We have replaced the stove in the Chelan house, and will be replacing the washing machine.

Falam Church has signed a contract with MLK church for use of the church building Saturday and Sunday evenings. They have been informed of the Washington State pandemic guidelines and are adhering to them.

We have an issue with moles on the property, at least 30 mounds have been found. Our Building and Grounds committee will be working with Terminex for a solution. One of the posts at the entrance to the church appears to have dry rot, and again, Building and Grounds will be dealing with this.

We as a ministry have been blessed to work together in harmony as fiscal agents for our church. We look forward to the time that we can meet in person, but until then we Zoom and stay safe.
